TANGO-NO-SEKKU Boy's Festival

May 5th is a National Holiday for Children's Day to celebrate children in general to grow up with a happy life and future, and it's called "Kodomo-no-Hi". Originally, however, the day was called Tango-no-Sekku or Boy's Festival and it was one of five names of Sekku, celebration days, including those for girls; Jōmi-no-Sekku in historical language. The five Sekku days consist of Jinjitsu (January 7th), Jōmi (March 3rd), Tango (May 5th), Tanabata (July 7th), and Chōyō (September 9).

Originally, boys were celebrated to grow up to be as strong as carp that swim up waterfalls, and families with boys set out dolls with warriors' armor and helmets, flying "Koi-Nobori" or Carp Streamers high up in the sky. There are not many of them these days but you will find them at some houses and that tells you they have boys. Families pray for their boys to grow like Koi (carp) and live their strong lives, and carp have long been taken as symbols of success in life.

The day also features from a long time ago the practice of taking a bath with sweet flag (iris), the so-called "Shōbu-Yu". Sweet flag is reputed to have medicinal effect, and its leaves are fragrant and are believed to get rid of evil. Also, it is essential to make an offering of the traditional Japanese confectionary of rice dumplings wrapped in bamboo shoot skins and rice cakes wrapped in oak leaves.

Golden week this year started on April 29th (Wed) and the holidays in May will be 3rd (Sun) Constitution Day, 4th (Mon) *Midori-no-Hi*, 5th (Tue) *Kodomo-no-Hi* and 6th (Wed) Substitute holiday.

SUPPLEMENTARY INCOME PAYMENTS AND EXTRA ALLOWANCE FOR CHILDREARING

定額給付金と 子育で応援特別手当

Based on the central government ordinance made recently, Chigasaki city issued a special publication last month notifying that an application form for receiving the Supplementary Income Payments and the Extra Allowance for Childrearing would be delivered to residents in mid-April.

The following is the city's notification on the procedure.

An application form was mailed to all the residents in April as written in the following items:

- (1) Chigasaki City dispatched the application form with a stamped addressed envelope enclosed on April 13, 2009.
- (2) The Application Form has to be mailed back by October 16, 2009.
- (3) Both the Supplementary Income Payments and the Extra Allowance for Childrearing will be transferred to the account of applicants/beneficiaries.

Outline of the Supplementary Income Payments:

Those eligible for the Supplementary Income Payments are the ones who have been registered either in the Basic Resident Ledger or foreigners who have completed alien registration as of February 1, 2009 (being called Base Day), and the amount to be paid follows:

Remarks: Foreigners who are staying in the city for a short period of time or those of illegal or undocumented people are excluded.

For those aged under 64 and over 19 (Born after February 3, 1944, or before February 1, 1990: **¥12,000 per head** For those aged over 65 (Born before February 2, 1944, or under 18 (Born after February 2, 1990: **¥20,000 per head**

*Those who apply for and receive the payments must be the head of a household as of February 1, 2009.

Outline of the Extra Allowance for Childrearing:

The extra allowance for supporting childrearing will be given to children who were born during April 2, 2002 through April 1, 2005 and not the first-born child.

For applicable child/children, **¥36,000 per head** will be paid to the head of a household.
