Basic Rules for Disposing of Garbage and Recyclable Materials

- ◆Garbage and recyclable materials have to be put out before 08:30 on the collection day at the point designated by the residents' association.
- ◆Please use transparent or translucent bags for garbage disposal.
- ◆Do not dispose of your garbage at another residents' association's collection point.
- ◆Do not dispose of your garbage on any days other than on the designated collection day; neither before nor after.
- ◆Disposal of recyclable materials generated from business at shops, eating establishments, offices, stores, etc. must be handled by each organization.
- ◆Please keep your garbage collection point clean.

Remarks: Details of Garbage and Recyclable Materials shown above are explained on the back of this page.

Attention:

Plastic containers and wrappings should be placed directly in the transparent or translucent bag being used for disposal. Do not put them inside another bag first as "plastics" within an inner bag may not melt properly.

Glass Bottles <Every other week>

Food and drink, cosmetic, and medicine bottles

- ◆Bottles used for agrochemicals, powerful drugs, etc. or milky-white bottles whose contents are not discernible are **Unburnable**.
- ◆Use up or empty and rinse inside.
- ◆Place on their sides in blue containers (after taking out of bags).

Cosmetic and medicine bottles must be disposed of as Bottles, but milky-white hottles whose contents are not discernible from the outside

Cans < Every other week>

Cans for drinks, liquor, cookies and other food, and spray cans

- ◆Use up or empty and rinse inside.
- ◆Don't crush.
- ◆Spray cans should be emptied and punctured in a well-ventilated place so that no gas remains.

PET Bottles <Every other week>

PET bottles for drinks, liquor, soy sauce. and syrupy sake (Only those with PET marks)



- ◆PET Bottles should be empty and rinsed inside.
- ◆Caps and Labels must be removed and disposed of as Plastic containers and wrappings.
- ◆PET Bottles should be crushed before being disposed of.

Metals (Only 10 designated items)

<Once a month>

Pans, Kettles, Frying pans, Spoons, Forks, Table Knives. Gridirons. Graters. Bowls. Colanders

- ◆ Table knives means knives used at the dining table.
- ◆ Teflon-processed and 'hōrō' (enamel) materials are accepted as Metals.
- ♠Rince or after getting rid of stain nut in wellow container provided

Plastic Containers and Wrappings

<Once a week>



All plastic containers and wrappings with 25 mark

(Plastic bags/wrappings, Cups, Trays/Packs, Bottles, Tubes, Buffer materials/Polystyrene foam, Net materials. Caps. etc.)

- •Remove caps, tear off labels, rinse with water, crush, and put into transparent or translucent bags.
- ◆If any stain remains after rinsing, discard as **Burnable**.

Burnable Garbage <Twice a week>

Food scraps, Paper scraps, Yard waste, Plastic bags/Trays/caps, Toothbrushes, Toothpaste tubes, Floor mats (front-door mats, kitchen mats, etc.), Shoes*, Lighters (emptied), etc.

- ◆Twigs and trunks acceptable as Burnable have to be less than 10cm in diameter and 50cm in length.
- ◆Video tapes, CDs/DVDs, etc. are **Burnable**.
- ◆All balls are Burnable, but bowling balls are Unburnable.
- *Leather shoes are included in **Burnable**, but Ski and Skate shoes are

Unburnable Garbage <Every other week>

Chinaware, Small-sized Electric Appliances, Electric bulbs, Fluorescent tubes (length up to 140cm), Glass scraps, Leather goods*, Ceramics, Dry cell batteries, etc.

- ◆Dry cells (small batteries) have to be put out in transparent bags separately from other unburnable items.
- ◆Plastic materials having no **77** mark (toys, buckets, etc.) are Unburnable.

*Leather shoes are **Burnable**.

Large-sized items

Prior booking is required by calling 0467-57-0200, getting a ¥500 ticket stamp to be attached to each item, and placing tagged items at the designated collection point.

◆Desks, Sofas, Sewing machines, Gas range/heaters, Stoves, etc.

Carried-in garbage and recyclable materials are accepted by the organizations listed on the right.

[Garbage] including Burnable, Unburnable, Large-sized, Specific-large-sized and Specific Bulky goes to the Environment Service Center for garbage reception and disposal. [Recyclable materials] as shown above go to the Environment Service Center. Samukawa Recycle Center accepts any non-recyclable garbage carried in.

Old Papers <Every other week>

Books, Magazines, Miscellaneous papers (Posters, Notebooks, Catalogues, Wrapping paper, Hand-carried Paper bags, Shredded paper, etc.)

Old Newspapers, Fliers, Paper cartons for drinks, Corrugated paperboard, Cardboard, Thick paper/board (Packaging for

Clothes and Cloth <Once a month>

Clothes, Sheets, Curtains, Blankets, Towels, Underwear, etc.

- ◆Clothes and cloth must be taken out after washing and placed in transparent or semi-transparent bags.
- Futon mats, and blankets/sheets/carpets with cotton wadding are Large-sized Garbage.

Used Cooking Oil <Once a month>

Cooking oil (Only vegetable oil such as Salad oil, Olive oil. Seed oil. etc.)

◆After cooling, put oil into a clear plastic container so that the contents are visible, close the lid securely, and put in the gray container

Other items

The City will not collect/accept:

- (1) Hazardous and difficult-to-handle items
- (2) Industrial waste
- (3) Specified household appliances
